WHO? By law, all dogs and cats over four months of age must be vaccinated for rabies and licensed. Cats are not required to be licensed in Mountain View and registration is optional. Licenses are not transferable from one owner to the next.

WHEN? Dogs and cats (excluding cats in Mountain View) must be licensed by the age of four months, or within thirty days of acquisition or within thirty days of residency or within sixty days of the expiration date of a previously issued license.

HOW? You may use the convenient application located on this brochure and mail or fax it to our office. Please provide proof of rabies vaccination and spay or neuter. You may also purchase a license at our office Tuesday-Sunday from 8a-5p.

LOST ANIMALS A licensed animal, wearing a tag, will be sheltered at least seven days. An unlicensed animal need only be kept four days. If your animal is lost anywhere, the license number can be traced back to you. A license can be a ticket home for your animal.

ANIMAL BITES Almost 200 dog and cat bites are reported every year in SVACA cities. Your animal license is proof that your animal has been vaccinated against rabies.

COST SAVINGS Spay or neuter your animal and receive reduced license fees. If your animal is unlicensed you can be cited and fined. You will also be subject to a late fee.

SPAY/NEUTER Three principal benefits arise from the spay or neuter of dogs and cats: 1) a reduced number of unwanted animals that end up in shelters; 2) healthier, longer-living animals; 3) lower licensing fees to animal owners and reduced expense to taxpayers for animal control costs. SVACA operates a low cost spay/neuter clinic. Call us at 408-764-0344 or go to www.svaca.com for more information.

LICENSE TERMS Please match the term of your rabies vaccination with the license tag term below, i.e. if your dog's rabies vaccination expires in one year, only a one year license can be issued. Please call us if you are unsure of what license term you are eligible for. NOTE: Only a one year license is available for unaltered dogs and cats.
